Your Excellency;

I am taking the liberty of writing to you on behalf of the Rev. Kim Kuk-gi, a citizen of the "Republic of Korea." He has been detained in the "Democratic People's Republic of Korea" (DPKR) since December of 2014 and was sentenced to life in prison by the Supreme Court in June of 2015. This Protestant Christian pastor had been living in Dandong City in China since the year 2003, where he has been assisting refugees, especially homeless children. He has also sent relief supplies to the DPKR. The allegations that have been raised against him, including that of espionage, which have led to this verdict, are without any foundation whatsoever.

I am therefore humbly asking you to advocate the immediate release of the Rev. Kim Kuk-gi and to permit him to return to homeland.
